Board of Commissioners Meeting Minutes For:

The meeting was called to order by Board Chair, Doug Lewey at 7:00 PM requesting roll call for Commissioner's present.

Town Hall Business:

2. Fire Chief Report (to include any Yolo County Fire Chief's Association report and any actions requested/taken from the Zamora Fire Volunteer Department or the Zamora Firehouse); Chief's report is allotted 15 minutes.

Chief Reported:

- 16 calls on the year
- First JOA training is this Saturday
- Chief's Association will potentially be utilizing the Pulse Point app and separating out "YEMSA" (Yolo County EMS Agency), for each agency to have their own community alerts. There would be a cost to do this, roughly \$500, if all departments involved want to participate. Chief will reach out to get more information on this and the estimated cost. Board says to get a final cost, ZFPD & ZFD could go 50/50 on the expense.
- Met with Supervisor Barajas regarding the 99W & County Road 13 intersection. There are some options for this area, flashing stop signs and rumble strips. Cannot do a four-way stop or speed reduction signs; the 45mph speed limit signs were only installed for a short period of time. Chief will send out emails to follow up.
- Assistant Chief reports: ZFD volunteer has become a Certified EMT, would like to supply him with a med bag.
