Board of Commissioners Meeting Minutes For:  
Wednesday, May 20, 2026, at 7:00 PM, Zamora Fire Station

The meeting was called to order by Board Chair, Doug Lewey at 7:00 PM requesting roll call for Commissioner's present.

1. Public Input/Open Forum (to include any discussions and/or actions needed/taken regarding the town hall); Each guest is allotted 15 minutes to share his/her business; given number of guests present.

Town Hall Business:

- Mobile voting will be at the Town Hall next Friday.
- When All American Services came out last August for the solar, he recommended a proper cleaning for the panels before doing anything further. When would the Board like to get the panels cleaned?  
With the work currently happening in the orchard, Board would like to table this until fall.

2. Fire Chief Report (to include any Yolo County Fire Chief's Association report and any actions requested/taken from the Zamora Fire Volunteer Department or the Zamora Firehouse); Chief's report is allotted 15 minutes.

Chief Reported:

- 40 calls for the year
- Chief was forwarded an email by CalFire regarding a home for sale in the District. A realtor needed a defensible space inspection. Chief reached out to Tanya Meyer, who has training in this and said she would help and submit notes to the realtor.
- Speedometer was fixed on W11
- Squad11's transmission is still being worked on.
- New volunteer has completed his probationary period and needs to be outfitted with gear. The department has taken inventory of all gear, and 2-3 members need new gear as well. This can be included in next fiscal year's budgeting. There is also a FEMA grant we could apply for.
- Badges for the commissioners were distributed. Chief will submit an invoice for reimbursement of this purchase.
- No new news on the pulse point split.
- Met with Supervisor Barajas and additional road crew to do site visits of 99W & 13, as well as the overpasses and County Road 91B that need attention. Regarding 99W & CR13, the quick fix would be to put in better stop signs and rumble strips, anything beyond that would need a study.

The overpass transitions are County responsibility to fix.  
They would like to address County Road 91B's drainage ditches.

- Discussed pull notice program at last Department meeting.

**3.** Discuss and possibly act on Pull Notice Program

- DSLC contacted GSRMA to get referral for information. GSRMA is partnered with plexus global to offer the Pull Notice Program for its members at no additional cost to the District. This provides continuous monitoring that alerts you in real time. Board agrees to go ahead with the program and requests DSLC to get set up and going. Chief will start collecting information from members.

**4.** Discuss and possibly act on Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Budget Draft

- Line-item review and discussion. Chief will pull numbers for the gear that's needed and follow up. DSLC is still waiting on numbers from GSRMA for '26-'27.
